PRE-NURSING PLANNING GUIDE

Admission Requirements: A minimum GPA of 2.75 is required to be considered for admission to the School of Nursing. You must have accrued 58 credit hours by the time you begin nursing studies. The School of Nursing does NOT accept course repeat. Other nursing programs may have additional admission requirements.

Application Deadline: The priority deadline is November 1. Those who submit completed applications before 11:59pm will have first consideration for admission and scholarships. We will continue to accept applications until January 15.
