PRE-CLINICAL LAB SCIENCES PLANNING GUIDE (KU CORE)

Admission Requirements: A minimum GPA of 2.7 (cumulative and science/math specific) is required to be considered for admission to the Clinical Laboratory Sciences program in the School of Health Professions. You must have accrued 57 credit hours by the time you begin CLS studies.

Application Deadline: One class is admitted each year. To be considered, applications must be completed by December 15 of the year preceding the desired fall semester entry.

- Science and math pre-requisite courses will only be accepted if they have been taken within the six years prior to submission of the application for admission to the CLS program.
- Virtual labs are not accepted. All labs must be completed on campus.
- A combined anatomy and physiology is only accepted if it is 8 hours and includes a lab.
