PRE-DIAGNOSTIC SCIENCE – DIAGNOSTIC ULTRASOUND & VASCULAR TECHNOLOGY PLANNING GUIDE (CORE 34)

Admission Requirements: To be eligible to apply to KU's bachelor's degree program in Diagnostic Science, students must be admitted to KU's Diagnostic Ultrasound and Vascular Technology Certificate Program. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 and a 'C' or higher in each course is required to be considered for admission. Admission is considered extremely competitive as limited spots are available.

Application Deadline: The deadline to apply is February 1. Applications must be complete to be considered for admission. If seats are still available, the program may accept applications after the deadline.

THINGS TO CONSIDER

- Students must complete 60 credit hours before starting the Respiratory Care program at the KUMC campus; this includes all prerequisites.
- Students who have completed a single combined anatomy and physiology course will need to complete either 1) second, higher-level anatomy and physiology course or 2) a separate course in physiology only.
- Students are encouraged to select elective courses, including biological sciences, behavioral sciences, math, or quantitative sciences, which help prepare for Respiratory Care
- Healthcare work or volunteer experience with patient contact is highly recommended.
- Two letters of reference are required. Instructors and supervisors are preferred, but Respiratory Care is flexible on this requirement.
