



PRE-OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY PLANNING GUIDE (KU CORE)

Pre-Occupational Therapy is a track made up of courses required for entry to KUMC's Occupational Therapy Doctoral program. Students complete these requirements alongside the bachelor's degree of their choice. Other schools may have different admission requirements.

Admission Requirements: A minimum of a 3.2 cumulative GPA is required for application. The application deadline is October 1.

REQUIRED

*Courses marked with an asterisk have prerequisites not already listed above. Please see a Pre-Health Academic Advisor for guidance.

- Human Anatomy with lab
 - Options at KU: BIOL 240* & BIOL 241
 - o Notes: A combined human anatomy & physiology course must be at least 8 hours to meet requirements.
- Human Physiology
 - Options at KU: BIOL 246*
 - o Notes: BIOL 247 lab is optional.
- Psychological Disorders
 - Options at KU: PSYC 350*
- Human Development
 - Options at KU: PSYC/ABSC 250*
- Social Science
 - Options at KU: Any course that fulfills KU Core 3S
 - o KU Core 3S
 - Notes: PSYC 104 fulfills KU Core 3S requirement and is a prerequisite for PSYC 210, PSYC 250, and PSYC 350.
- Statistics
 - Options at KU: MATH 365*, PYSC 210* or COMS 356
 - KU Core 1.2
 - o Notes: COMS 356 required admission to the Communication Studies major or instructor permission.
- Ethics
 - o Options at KU: PHIL 160
 - o KU Core 5.1
- Medical Terminology
 - Options at KU: HEIM 230 or CLSX 332
 - o Notes: CLSX 332 fulfills KU Core Goal 3H.

REQUIRED

- Sociology
 - Options at KU: SOC 104
 - o KU Core 4.1
 - Notes: Required for other OT programs.





THINGS TO CONSIDER

- 18 of 24 required admission hours must be completed before applying, with anatomy and physiology included in those 18 hours. Any remaining admission requirements must be completed by the start of the OT program.
- No grade lower than a C will be accepted on prerequisite courses. Students must have a 3.2 GPA for prerequisite courses.
- Healthcare experience with an occupational therapist with direct patient contact is no longer required for KU but is required for some programs.
- The GRE is not required for KU's OT program, and scores are not considered in the admission process. It is required for some programs.
- The admission process includes a personal statement, three references, and an interview. References should be written by a professional, advisor, instructor, or supervisor who can attest to the applicant's potential success in the program and future contributions to the occupational therapy profession.
- Applications may be submitted with coursework still in progress but must indicate the student's plan for completion prior to beginning the program. All prerequisites must be completed before starting OT coursework.
