



PRE-PHARMACY PLANNING GUIDE (KU CORE)

Admission Requirements: A minimum Pre-Pharmacy GPA of 2.5 is required to be considered. Students must have completed 67 hours of college coursework before entry. Pre-requisite courses may be in progress at time of application. Students in the Early Assurance Pathway must complete additional requirements as Pre-Pharmacy students. Please see below for additional information.

Application Deadline: Students must apply using the PharmCAS application. The application cycle runs from August 1-June 1, in the academic year prior to pharmacy school entry. Students are encouraged to apply early for priority application review and interview scheduling as decisions are made on a rolling basis. The School of Pharmacy admits one cohort to start in the fall semester of each year.

THINGS TO CONSIDER

- The School of Pharmacy's Pharm.D. program is considered a 2 + 4 program. Students complete at least 2 years of college coursework before entry, followed by four years of professional education.
- All Pre-Pharmacy coursework must be completed with a grade of C- or better. Pre-Pharmacy GPA must be 2.5 or higher to be considered for admission.
- Credit/No Credit grading is NOT recommended for science classes.
- The KU School of Pharmacy does NOT practice grade replacement. All grades are averaged together.
- Students admitted to the Early Assurance Pathway have additional requirements as Pre-Pharmacy students:
 - Students must attend the University of Kansas and complete a substantial majority of Pre-Pharmacy coursework at KU within three academic years of entering KU.
 - Students must meet with a Pre-Pharmacy advisor in Jayhawk Academic Advising at least once per semester.
 - Students must achieve a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale in all Pre-Pharmacy coursework and all Pre-Pharmacy chemistry, biology and math courses.
 - Students must complete all Pre-Pharmacy courses as published in the KU Academic Catalog and achieve a grade of C- or above in each course.
 - Students must complete the PharmCAS application by June 1 during the school year prior to entering the KU Pharm.D. program.
 - o Students must maintain membership in the KU Pre-Pharmacy Club.
 - Students should complete PHAR 101 before completion of the PharmCAS application.
 - Students are strongly encouraged to complete at least 10 hours of pharmacy observation/work.
