CURRICULUM GUIDE

The pre-health information management track contains courses during the first two years of college required to be considered for admissions to the bachelor's degree in health information management at KU Medical Center.

Classes needed to finish KU's minor in business:

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GPA:

2.50 grade point average overall is required, with a grade of "C" or better on each course.

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

February 1 is the deadline for priority admission status. Applications are accepted past this date as seats in the class remain available. It is strongly recommended students visit the program website to review all admission requirements at least the year before applying.

NOTE:

Students must complete 60 credit hours before starting the program at the KU Medical Center campus.
