

## PRE-HEALTH INFORMATION MANAGEMENT PLANNING GUIDE (KU CORE)

**Admission Requirements:** A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required to be considered for admission to the Health Information Management program at KUMC. A grade of C or better is required for all prerequisites. **Application Deadline:** The priority deadline is February 1 each year. If seats are still available, the program may accept applications after the deadline.
