

For KU Lawrence students seeking admission to KUMC:

PRE-HEALTH INFORMATION MANAGEMENT PLANNING GUIDE

Admission Requirements: A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required to be considered for admission to the Health Information Management program at KUMC. A grade of C or better is required for all pre-requisites.

Application Deadline: The priority deadline is February 1 each year. If seats are still available, the program may accept applications after the deadline.

 - Options at KU: ACCT 200*

 - Fulfills KU Core Goal 3S

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Students are required to complete 60 credit hours before starting the HIM program.
- Goals 1.1, 5 & 6 will be fulfilled in the Health Information Management curriculum.
- A Health Care Management minor is available.
- Two references are required: one from an instructor and one from a manager or supervisor.
- Schedule an appointment with the career center to prepare your resume for application.
- In order to be admitted, students will be asked to verify that they can meet the technical standards (visual/auditory, sensory/motor, etc.) with or without accommodations. Applicants who disclose a disability are considered for admission if they are otherwise qualified.
- Beyond the above pre-requisites, students can earn a minor in business by completing an additional three business classes: MKTG 305/310, FIN 305/310, and SCM 305/310. Students will take a management course that will fulfill the final minor requirement.
