

MOCK INTERVIEW TOOL

The Mock Interview Tool in HireJayhawks allows you to practice responding to interview questions. It will provide a question and then records your answer using your computer's camera and microphone. Once completed, you can review your responses and also share with a career coach or instructor to receive feedback.

To access the Mock Interview Tool, log into HireJayhawks with your KU Online ID and Password and then select Career Prep Resources – Mock Interview Tool in the left menu. Select the Recommended Interviews tab. There are General Interview questions and the "LA&S 470 Mock Interview Assignment - Healthcare professional" with questions specific to healthcare professionals.

PATHWAYS

The Pre-Health Pathway provides a targeted career plan and preparation checklist. It can be accessed by logging into HireJayhawks.com with your KU Online ID and Password and then selecting Career Prep Resources – Pathways in the left menu.

The pathway is organized by timeframe and what you should do during your First Year, Second Year, Third Year, and Fourth Year. Each task has instructions and additional details by clicking the ? icon. Once you have completed a task, check it off. The pathway will calculate your completion of each section as well as your overall completion for the entire pathway.


