IMPORTANT NOTES, CONT'D

- A combined human anatomy/physiology course that is at least 5 credit hours and includes a lab may be used to fulfill the anatomy & physiology requirements.
- Course Repeat is allowed; Credit/No Credit is not allowed for courses in the Pre-PT track.
- Applicants must possess a general understanding of health care and physical therapy based upon employment, observation and/or volunteer experiences. A specific number of hours is not required, but one reference must be from a physical therapy.
